All sections of the application must be completed in full. Applications must include the endorsement of your Faculty/Department/School at the University which you attend. The "National Police Check Application and Consent Forms" provided separately must also be completed and attached to the ELTF application form.

The signed original of the completed application together with certified documentary evidence of your Australian citizenship or permanent resident status in Australia together with academic transcript of tertiary language and teacher education studies completed/enrolled should be sent in hard copy form to the Asia Education Foundation (AEF) at the address set out on page v.

The deadline for the submission of applications is **5.00 pm Friday 20 July 2007**. Applications that are not received at the offices of the AEF by this deadline may not be accepted. 1 Objectives of the ELTF

The Endeavour Language Teacher Fellowships (ELTF) are an exciting Australian Government initiative for practising language teachers and trainee (pre-service) language teachers to improve their language proficiency and cultural knowledge through an intensive, short-term, study programme. The Asia Education Foundation (AEF) manages the ELTF on behalf of the Australian Government Department of Education, Science and Training (DEST).

The broad objectives of the ELTF are to:

- provide practising language teachers and trainee language teachers with the opportunity to improve their knowledge, skills and understanding of the languages and cultures about which they will teach;
- help develop a pool of language teachers with recent in-country experience and expertise as a resource at school, system, state and national levels;
- strengthen linkages between educators in Australia and in targeted countries;
- promote the value of languages education in Australian schools; and
- strengthen mutual understanding between the people of participating countries.

More specifically the ELTF programme aims to:

- provide intensive professional learning to increase language proficiency levels of language teachers and trainee language teachers; and
- strengthen networking among language teachers and trainee language teachers nationally and in each State/Territory.

2 2008 ELTF Study Programmes Description

The 2008 ELTF for trainee language teachers consists of three in-country programmes and an onshore Bahasa Indonesia (Indonesian language) immersion programme held in Darwin, Australia.

A In-country ELTF study programmes

For 2008, ELTF awards will be offered nationally to trainee language teachers of Chinese, Japanese and Arabic to participate in in-country study programmes in China, Japan and either Jordan or the United Arab Emirates respectively.

While the specific arrangements may vary across study programmes, each ELTF programme will include three weeks of intensive language and cultural study. In order to make the most of the study programme, participants should be physically fit enough to carry their own luggage, flexible and tolerant in outlook and possess team-player spirit so that they can fully participate in the programme.

Language study component

The language study component of the programmes will focus primarily on improving participants' proficiency in the language, not on teaching methodologies. The language study programmes will be conducted at language training institutions with experience in delivering similar programmes to language teachers from Australia or other countries.

Cultural component

In-country programme participants will also have the opportunity to visit a variety of places, make local contacts where possible, be exposed to contemporary life, as well as to immerse

themselves in the language through day-to-day interactions. Group activities are a feature of the ELTF programme.

Group Leaders

Each ELTF study programme will be assigned a Group Leader who will accompany and work with participants to support and extend their learning, thereby ensuring that participants gain the most from their experience. Group Leaders will also assist in managing programme logistics, finances, liaison with programme deliverers and travel providers to assist in the smooth running of the programme.

Costs covered

The in-country study programme will include costs of all domestic air travel within Australia to connect to an international airport, international return air travel (economy class) and mid-range twin or triple-share accommodation and/or home stays, some meals (as advised in pre-departure briefings), language tuition fees and field trip costs.

Costs not covered

Participants will be responsible for the costs of some meals and tips, their own out-of-pocket expenses such as laundry, telephone and Internet, travel and medical insurance, health checks and inoculations, visa fees and other incidentals (as advised in pre-departure briefings).

It is a requirement that all ELTF participants have valid comprehensive travel and medical insurance for the entire duration of the study programme, covering expenses that may arise in connection with injury or illness (including any pre-existing medical condition), emergency repatriation costs, personal liability, loss of or damage to personal effects, cancellation, and additional expenses incurred that relate to any of the above risks.

B Bahasa Indonesia Programme offered in Australia

The Bahasa Indonesia programme will be delivered onshore in Darwin, Australia. Successful applicants will be provided with full details in October 2007. This programme will comprise a three-week residential intensive language study and cultural programme.

Language Study component

The Bahasa Indonesia programme will focus on strengthening language proficiency with the opportunity to explore teaching methodology for Bahasa Indonesia programmes in Australian schools. Indonesian language specialists, including native language speaking teachers from Indonesia, will be integral to the programme and participants will have the opportunity to immerse themselves in the language through day-to-day interactions in a range of activities.

Cultural component

Participants can expect cultural activities and structured opportunities to interact with Indonesian native speakers as a regular feature of the Bahasa Indonesia Programme. Participants will also have the opportunity to access realia from Indonesia (eg posters, brochures, etc) for use in their classrooms.

Participants in the Bahasa Indonesia programme held in Darwin will be allowed to apply in the future should an overseas in-country ELTF Indonesian Language programme be offered by DEST.

Group Leaders

The study programme will be assigned a Group Leader who will accompany and work with participants to support and extend their learning, thereby ensuring that participants gain the most from their experience. The Group Leader will also assist in managing programme logistics, finances, liaison with programme deliverers and travel providers to assist in the smooth running of the programme.

Costs covered

The Bahasa Indonesia Programme will include return domestic air travel (economy class) between the applicant's home port and the location of the Bahasa Indonesia Programme in Australia, mid-range twin-share or triple-share accommodation or equivalent, most meals, language study programme fees and field trip costs

Costs not covered

Participants will be responsible for the costs of some meals, their own out-of-pocket expenses such as laundry, telephone, Internet, health checks and other incidentals (as advised in pre-departure briefings).

It is a requirement that all ELTF participants on the Bahasa Indonesia programme have valid comprehensive insurance for the entire duration of the study programme, covering expenses that may arise in connection with injury or illness (including any pre-existing medical condition), emergency repatriation costs, personal liability, loss of or damage to personal effects, cancellation, and additional expenses incurred that relate to any of the above risks.

4 Who is eligible to apply?

To be eligible for consideration for an ELTF award, an applicant must:

- complete the application form contained in this document;

- address each of the selection criteria set out on page vi;
- agree to a criminal history check (by completing the National Police Check Application and Consent Forms); and

meet the following eligibility criteria:

- be an Australian citizen or have permanent resident status in Australia;
- be of good character and conduct;
- be currently enrolled in an approved primary or secondary teacher education course in Australia to become a teacher of Arabic, Chinese, Japanese or Indonesian;
- have the written support of his/her Faculty/Department/School at the university he/she attends;
- provide certified documentary evidence of his/her Australian citizenship or permanent resident status in Australia and academic transcript of tertiary language and teacher education studies; and
- not have participated in an Endeavour Language Teacher Fellowships programme previously.

Preference may be given to applicants who have successfully completed at least two years' tertiary language study of the target language.

Applicants who have less than two years' tertiary language study are eligible to apply but do so on the understanding that preference may be given to applicants as described above.

Applicants will be required to make a self-assessment of their language level on the application form and provide documentary evidence of their tertiary language study.

Preference may also be given to applicants who have limited in-country experience.

To assist language training institutions in devising their programmes, participants will undergo language proficiency testing prior to the commencement of the study programme. Further details will be provided to successful applicants.

5 How to apply

To submit an application for the 2008 ELTF programme please complete the application form (in the following pages) and attach certified documentary evidence of your Australian citizenship or permanent resident status in Australia together with your academic transcript of tertiary language and teacher education studies and forward the signed original application to:

Applications must include your university Faculty/Department/School's endorsement. Please ensure you include the "National Police Check Application and Consent Forms" together with a photocopy of your driver's licence and/or alternate I.D. with your photograph.

The deadline for applications is 5.00 pm Friday 20 July 2007. Applications that are not received at the offices of the AEF by this deadline may not be accepted.

6 What are the selection criteria that applicants must address?

The selection criteria are set out below. Applicants are strongly advised to consider the prompts provided under each of the criteria in composing their responses to the selection criteria.

a) Evidence of commitment to quality languages teaching

- What do you believe are the attributes of a good languages teacher?
- How will your experience in the ELTF Programme enhance your teaching in the classroom?
- What are your personal learning goals in participating in the ELTF Programme?
- Why do you believe the study of another language is important?

b) Evidence of your capacity to act as an ambassador for the Endeavour Language Teacher Fellowships Programme.

- Describe the personal qualities and attributes that you possess and any relevant experience that demonstrates your capacity to be an enthusiastic and positive participant in the ELTF Programme and a role model for other trainee language teachers.

7 How the Applicants will be assessed

Participants will be selected for an ELTF award by a selection panel (the 'panel') established by the AEF in consultation with the Department of Education, Science and Training (DEST). The panel will comprise at least one representative from DEST, a representative from a State/Territory education department, a representative of the Australian Federation of Modern Language Teachers Associations (AFMLTA), a representative of the AEF and a teacher educator.

Only applications that have satisfied each of the eligibility criteria will be considered by the panel.

In selecting applicants, the panel will take into account:

- the quality of applicant's responses to the selection criteria;
- the support statement provided by the applicant's Faculty/Department/School at the university he/she attends;
- the language proficiency level of the applicant; and

- the nature of any prior in-country experience (if any).

The AEF will submit the list of applicants to DEST that are recommended by the panel to receive the ELTF Awards. DEST will submit the National Police Check Application and Consent Forms of the short-listed applicants to the Australian Federal Police for clearance. DEST will then, at its absolute discretion, make the final decision on which applicants will be given the ELTF Awards.

No correspondence will be entered into in relation to DEST's decision on the selected applicants.

8 Will feedback be provided to unsuccessful applicants?

Feedback will not be provided as to why applicants were not selected. The number of eligible applicants greatly outnumbers the awards available. Final selection, including selection procedures, is at the discretion of DEST and no correspondence will be entered into.

9 Terms and Conditions that successful applicants must agree to

Successful applicants (participants) who participate in the programme are required to actively engage and participate in all aspects of the programme and must agree to the following terms and conditions:

a) *No other commitments between 30 December 2007 - 23 January 2008 university vacation*

Participants selected for the programme will undertake the programme during the period, 30 December 2007 – 23 January 2008, of the university vacation. Participants must ensure they have no other commitments during this period. It is expected that exact dates for specific study programmes will be confirmed with participants in October 2007. Neither the Australian Government nor the programme organisers will be required to pay any allowances or salary reimbursement to participants.

NOTE: Some universities have their own requirements regarding their students travelling interstate or overseas on a study programme. Participants must check with the relevant authority at the University to ensure all requirements are met in this regard.

b) *Pre-departure Preparation*

Prior to commencement of the programme, participants are expected to prepare for their participation in the programme. Participants are expected to read all information on the itinerary, programme organisation and country background that is provided by the AEF and participate in comprehensive briefings and opportunities to network with other participants via e-mail discussion groups and teleconferences.

c) *Medical Certificate*

Successful applicants are required to provide a medical certificate that certifies that they are medically and physically fit to participate in the programme. Further details will be provided as part of the pre-departure preparation.

d) Passports

Participants must ensure that they possess a valid passport that does not expire before July 2008. In the event that they do not have a current passport, participants must be willing to undertake the necessary steps to have a passport finalised by October 2007.

e) Travel arrangements

Participants are not permitted to vary the group travel arrangements in any way.

Family members and partners are not permitted to accompany participants on the programme.

f) Reporting requirements

On completion of the programme, participants must submit a report on the outcomes of their participation in the programme to the AEF by 25 April 2008.

The report will provide information on how the participant has benefited from the study programme and how he/she will share the knowledge with fellow trainee language teachers. A proforma document will be made available to participants as part of pre-departure briefings.

g) Unsafe Travel

Participants acknowledge that DEST may, at its absolute discretion, alter, delay or withdraw the offer of an ELTF Award. For example, this may be as a result of the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT) travel advice that it is not safe to travel to any part of the country that is a proposed ELTF destination.

h) Condition of Award

All short-listed applicants will be required to undergo a criminal history check prior to being granted an ELTF award. The "National Police Check Application and Consent Forms" together with the relevant information is available on the ELTF webpage at:

for your completion. DEST will submit your application (and pay for the fees) for a police check if you are short-listed for an ELTF Award. In completing the form you must specify that the check is being sought in order to comply with the requirements of the Australian Government Department of Education, Science and Training. Please ensure you include a photocopy of your driver's licence and/or alternate I.D. with your photograph.

It is an important consideration for DEST in making the ELTF Awards that recipients are suitable persons who will enhance the reputation of Australia and the ELTF Programme overseas and locally.

A criminal record will not automatically disqualify an applicant from receiving an ELTF Award. However, if an applicant is found to have a criminal record/conviction which DEST considers to be of a serious nature then DEST may, at its absolute discretion, refuse to grant the person an ELTF Award.

All applicants also acknowledge that the Department may, at its absolute discretion, vary or reverse any decision regarding the ELTF award made on the basis of incorrect, incomplete or misleading information.

10 General information

a) Freedom of Information

All documents created or held by DEST with regard to the Endeavour Language Teacher Fellowships programme are subject to the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (FOI Act). Unless a document falls under an exemption provision, it will be made available to the general public if requested under the FOI Act. All FOI requests are to be referred to the Principal Government Lawyer, Litigation and External Review Section, Procurement, Assurance and Legal Group, in the Department of Education, Science and Training (DEST) National Office. Decisions regarding requests for access will be by the authorised FOI decision-maker in accordance with the requirements of the FOI Act.

b) Disclaimer

DEST, AEF and the selection panel will not accept responsibility for any misunderstanding arising from the failure by an applicant to comply with the requirements set out in the application pack, or arising from any ambiguity, discrepancy, inconsistency, error or omission contained in the application pack.

The deliberations of the selection panel, AEF and DEST will remain confidential. DEST reserves the right not to provide the full number of awards in any year. All recommendations made by the panel and decisions taken by DEST shall be binding and final, and no correspondence will be entered into on such matters.

c) Privacy statement

All material received from applicants by the AEF, DEST and the panel is accepted on the understanding that such material may only be used:

- in assessing applications for the 2008 ELTF Awards;
- in administering the 2008 ELTF Awards; and
- for the purposes of informing Australian Government Members of Parliament and the public about the outcomes of the ELTF Programme. (Australian Government Members of Parliament are persons to whom such information is usually disclosed).

All information collected or created will be treated in accordance with the *Privacy Act 1988* which prevents personal information from being disclosed without appropriate consent, unless disclosure is required or authorised by law.

DEST and the AEF may publish the names of recipients of the ELTF Awards, the university at which the Award recipients are enrolled and details of the study programme for which the person was selected for promotion and publicity concerning the ELTF Programme.
